Priority ranking in 2014	Goal
1	Maintain existing foundation vineyards
2	Audit disease status of existing foundation collections
3	Develop new testing techniques including the most appropriate new technologies
4	Develop most appropriate methods for effective and rapid elimination of pathogens
5	Develop list of pathogens for which standard testing methods will be used to qualify for foundation vineyard
6	Perform disease elimination therapy on as many new selections as possible
7	Develop standards for selection, maintenance and testing of foundation vineyards
8	Develop outreach program to grape growers, nurseries and consumers to explain the value of clean plant programs
9	Study new pathogens and vectors that introduce disease
10	Develop documents and publications for distribution in outreach program
11	True to type determination is important when it comes to maintaining the permanent collection; otherwise, it is an industry responsibility
12	Develop a transparent prioritization system for orderly distribution of plant material when supply is limited
13	Do a study to better understand the economic impact of clean plant programs
14	Establish new foundation vineyards
15	Inventory existing capabilities, roles and authorities
16	Develop procedures and fees schedules for incorporating proprietary clones into clean plant programs
17	Import as many new varieties and clones as possible
18	Develop private website to distribute information among grape network
